ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Caronine, County of Greenville, in Glassy Mountain Township containing 361 acres, more or less, being described as Tract No. 55 in a deed to Mountain/Land Improvement Go., Inc. dated October 31, 1955 recorded in Deed Book 538 at page 531 in the RMC Office for Greenville County. Reference is hereby made to the aforesaid deed for a more particular description of the subject property.

ALSO: All that lot of land in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Glassy Mountain Township, adjoining the first tract described herein, and containing 70 acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds; to-wit:
