NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the scaling and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the southern side of Huntington Road near

the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 64 as shown on plat of Sheet No. 3 of Huntington Subdivision, prepared by Piedmont Engineers and Architects, dated May 4, 1968, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book WWW at page 25, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Huntington Road at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 64 and 65 and running thence with the line of Lot No. 65, S. 18-02 E. 386.79 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 64-50 W. 180 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of property now or formerly of Ballenger N. 25-11 W. 467.7 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 63 and 64; thence with the line of Lot No. 63 N. 4-38 W. 49.1 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of Huntington Road; thence with the southern side of Huntington Road, S. 79-22 E. 173.7 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the southern side of Huntington Road, N. 86-49 E. 75. 6 feet to the point of beginning.

Together with all and singular rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and fincluding all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures now or hereafter attacked, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its heirs, successors and assigns, forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and is lawfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except as provided herein. The Mortgagor further concurants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagor forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
