14. That in the event this mortgage should be foreclosed, the Mortgagor expressly waives the benefits of Sections 45-88 through 45-96.1 of the 1962 Code of Laws of South Carolina, as amended, or any other appraisement laws.

- 1. Should any legal proceedings be instituted for the foreclosure of this mortgage, or should the Mortgagee become a party to any suit involving this Mortgage or the title to the premises described herein, or should the debt secured hereby or any part thereof be placed in the hands of an attorney at law for collection by suit or otherwise, all costs and expenses incurred by the Mortgagee, and a reasonable attorney's fee, shall thereupon become due and payable immediately or on demand, at the option of the Mortgagee, as a part of the debt secured thereby, and may be recovered and collected hereunder.
