The Mortgager further covenants and agrees as follows:

- (3) That it will keep all improvements now existing or hereafter erected in good repair, and, in the case of a construction lean, that it will continue construction until completion without interruption, and should it fail to do so, the Mortgages may, at its epitent enter upon said premises, make whatever repair, are necessary, including the completion of any construction work underway, and charge the expenses for such repairs or the completion of such construction to the mortgage debt.
- (4) That it will pay, when due, all taxes, public assessments, and other governmental or municipal charges, fines or other impositions against the mortgaged pramises. That it will comply with all governmental and municipal laws and regulations affecting the mortgaged premises.
- (5) That it hereby assigns all cents, issues and profits of the mortgaged premises from and after any default hereunder, and egreece that, should legal proceedings be instituted pursuant to this instrument, any judge having jurisdiction may, at Chambers or etherwise, appoint a receiver of the mortgaged premises, with full authority to take possession of the mortgaged premises and collect the rents, issues and profits, including a reasonable rental to be fixed by the Court in the event said premises are occupied by the mortgager and after deducting all charges and expenses attending such praceeding and the execution of its trust as receiver, shall apply the residue of the rents, issues and profits toward the payment of the debt secured hereby.
- (6) That if there is a default in any of the terms, conditions, or covenants of this mortgage, or of the note secured hereby, then, at the option of the Mortgagee, all sums then owing by the Moragagorio the Mortgagee shall become immediately due and payable, and this mortgage may be foreclosed. Should any legal proceedings be instituted for the foreclosure of this mortgage, or should the Martgage become a party of any suit involving this Mortgage or the title to the premises described herein, or should the debt secured hereby or any part thereof be placed in the hands of any alterney at law for collection by suit or otherwise, all costs and expenses incurred by, the Mortgagee, and a reasonable attorney's fee, shall thereupon become due and payable immediately or on demand, at the option of the Mortgagee, as a part of the debt secured hereby, and may be recovered and collected hereunder.
- (7) That the Morrgagor shall held and enjoy the premises above conveyed until there is a default under this mertgago or in the note secured hereby. It is the true meaning of this instrument that if the Morrgagor shall fully perform all the terms, cenditions, and coverants of the morrgage, and of the note secured hereby, that then this morrgage shall be ulterly null and void; otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.

(8) That the covenents herein contained shall bind, and the benefits and advantages shall inure to, the respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, of the parties herato. Whenever used, the singular shall included the plural, the plural the singular, and the use of any gender shall be applicable to all genders.
