WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto Clarence F. Johnson and Gladys B. Johnson (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, On the Southern side of Buena Vista Street, in the City of Greenville, being shown as Lot No. 20 of Block B on plat of property of Corrine Bates, recorded in Plat Book S at Page 183 and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake onthe Southern side of Buena Vista Street, 432.3 feet East from Batesview Drive, at corner of Lot 19, and running thence with the line of said lot, S. 31-20 E. 203 feet to a stake at corner of Lot 29; thence with the line of said lot, N. 58-10 E. 100 feet to a stake at corner of Lot 21; thence with the line of said lot, N. 31-20 W. 203 feet to a stake on Buena Vista Street; thence with the Southern side of Buena Vista Street, S. 58-10 W. 100 feet to the beginning corner.
