MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated berein by reference, in the sum of Thirty-five Thousand and no 100 ths-----Dollars (\$ 35, 000.00 Ldue and payable ONE YEAR FROM DATE,

per, centum per annum, to be paid: semi-annually. with interest thereon from date at the rate of

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, of for any other purposes:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee. before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with all buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 19 on a plat of THOMAS F. PARKER made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, in February, 1916, revised, January 5th, 1922, and recorded in the Greenville County RMC Office in Plat Book E, page 115, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Williams Street at the intersection of Williams Street and a ten foot alley; thence with the eastern side of Williams Street, S. 14-54 E., 86.5 feet to an iron pin, the corner of Lot No. 20; thence with the joint line of Lots Nos. 19 and 20, N. 75-06 E., 155.4 feet to an iron pin on the western side of an alley; thence with the western side of said alley N. 13-23 W., 105 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 64-15 W. 12.7 feet to an iron pin on the south said of an alley; thence with the southern side of said alley, S. 64 W. 151 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.

This junior or second mortgage is made subject and subordinate to a prior mortgage on the premises made by the mortgagor to First Federal Savings and Loan Association, dated December 2nd, 1958, given to secure the payment of \$21,000.00, and interest and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Mortgage Book 779, page 151, said mortgage having a balance due in, the sum of \$8,597.35.

Together with all and substant rights, members, herditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging in any way incident or apportaining, and of all the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its heirs, successors and assigns, forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and is lawfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except as provided herein. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrent and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagoe forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomselve a wildly claiming the same or any part thereof.

The Mortgagor further covenants and agrees as follows:

⁽¹⁾ That this mortgage shall secure the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs or other purposes pursuant to the covenants herein. This mortgage shall also secure the Mortgagee for any further loans, advances, readvances or credits that may be made hereafter to the Mortgager by the Mortgagee so long as the total indebtedness this secured does not exceed the original amount shown on the face hereof. All sums so advanced shall be at interest at the same rate as the mortgage debt and shall be payable and of the Mortgagee unless otherwise provided in writing.

⁽²⁾ That it will keep the improvements now existing a hereafter erected on the mortgaged property insured as may be required from time to time by the Mortgagee against loss by fire and any alleg hazards specified by Mortgagee, in an amount not less than the nortgage debt, or such amotints as may be required by the Mortgagee, and in companies acceptable to it, and that all such policies and tenewals thereof shall be held by the Mortgagee, and have attached thereto loss payable clauses in favor of, and in form acceptable to the Mortgagee, and that it will pay all premiums therefor when due; and that it does hereby assign to the Mortgagee the proceeds of any policy insuring the mortgaged premises and does hereby authorize each fusurance company concerned to make payment for a loss directly to the Mortgagee, to the extent of the balance owing on the Mortgage debt, whether due or not.
