TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, including all built-in stores and refrigerators, heating, air conditioning, planding and electrical futures, wall to wall carpeting, fences and gates, and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected or fitted in any manner, it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than household furniture, be considered a part of the realty.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns forever.

The Mortgagor represents and warrants that said Mortgagor is seized of the above described premises in fee simple absolute, that the above described premises are free and clear of all lieus or other encumbrances; that the Mortgagor is liwfully empowered to convey or encumber the same, and that the Mortgagor will forever detend the said premises unto the Mortgagor, its successors and assigns, from and against the Mortgagor and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
