MURTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE
ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCE

WHEREAS, We, Kenneth W. Moore and Love of Etc. 4005.6 are

(hereinalter referred to as Mortgagor) M well and truly indebted junto 27 3 36 PH 173

A. C. Anders and Thelma R. Anders TANKERSLEY

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's profilestry note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of Thirty-Two Thousand and No/100------

as follows: an interest payment of \$62.22 on August 5, 1973, and thereafter monthly interest payments of \$186.67 on the 5th day of each succeeding month until January 5, 1974, and thereafter in monthly installments of \$329.09 beginning on January 5, 1974, and continuing on the 5th day of each succeeding month thereafter until paid in full, said payments to be applied first to interest and then to the principal balance remaining due from month to month with the privilege * with interest thereon from date at the rate of seven (7) per centum per annum, to be paid: monthly of anticipating payment of the entire principal debt or any part thereof at any time after January 1, 1974.

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may bereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purposes:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagor at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagor, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagor at and before the scaling and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagor, its successors and assigns:

H.
