All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, hing and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the northern side of Bransfield Road, being known and designated as Lot No. 451 as shown on plat entitled DEL NORTE ESTATES, SECTION V, dated Hay 23, 1972, prepared by Piedmont Engineers and Architects, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book 4-R at Page 17, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of Bransfield Road at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 451 and 452 and running thence with the common line of said Lots, N. 8-12 M. 129.9 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 81-10 E. 95.0 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 450 and 451; thence running with the common line of said Lots, S. 8-10 E. 131.1 feet to an iron pin on the northern side of Bransfield Road; thence running with the northern side of said Road, S. 81-57 M. 95.0 feet to the point of beginning.
