TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the property rate the Government and its essigns forever.

BORROWER for himself, his beirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns WARRENTS THE TITLE to the property to the Government against all level claims and demands whatsoever except any lieus, encumbrances, essencets, reservations, or conveyances specified hereinshove, and COVENANTS AND AGREES as follows:

(1) To pay promptly when due any indebtedness to the Government hereby necured and to indemnify and save harnless the Govern spainst may loss under its innumer of payment of the note by reason of any default by Borrower. At all times when the note is held by an innumer chall continue to make payments on the note to the Government, as collection agent for the holder.

(2) To pay the Government such fees and other charges as may now or hereafter be required by regulations of the Farmers Home Administration.

(3) At all times when the note is held by an insured lender, any amount doe and unpaid under the terms of the note, less the amount of any amount charge, may be paid by the Government to the holder of the note as provided in the insurance endorsement for the account of Borrower. Any amount due and unpaid under the terms of the note, whether it is held by the Government or by an insured lender, may be credited by the Government on the note, and therespon shall constitute an advance by the Government or the account of Borrower.
