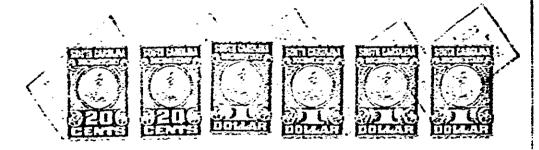

ALL those pieces, parcels or lots of land situate, lying and being in Cleveland Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, in Pioneer Park (also known as Lakemont Colony) and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 209 & 210 on Map No. 2 of Pioneer Park property recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "G", at page 82, reference to said plat being craved for a metes and bounds description thereof.



Together with all and singular rights, members, herdraments, and apportenances to the same belonging in any way incident or apportaining, and of all the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had thereform, and including all heating, planning, and lighting fintures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fintures and equipment, other than the areal bounded formings, he considered a part of the real extate.
