_____ Dollars (\$10,000.00) due and payable January 5, 1974 with interest thereom from date at the rate of of eight (8%) percent to be paid at maturity.



NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by the present, does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land with all buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being on the southern side of Gibson Circle being a portion of the property shown on a survey for H. Z. Jones by Piedmont Engineers dated January 19, 1957 and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book FF, page 525 and having according to a plat of the property of C. R. Carter and Stella Carter made by W. R. Williams, Jr. dated May 14, 1970 the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Gibson Circle at the corner of property now or formerly belonging to Charles Neely and running thence along Neely's line, S. 10-52 W. 416 feet to an iron pin in the line of property now or formerly owned by Jones; thence along Jones' line, S. 74-58 E. 85 feet to an iron pin; thence along property now or formerly owned by C. R. Carter, N. 10-17 E. 259.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 26-28 E. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 11-35 E. 58.4 feet to an iron pin on Gibson Circle; thence along the southern side and through a portion of Gibson Circle, N. 74-58 W. 110 feet to the point of beginning.



Together with all and singular rights, members, berditaments, and apportenances to the same belonging in any way incident or appertaining, and of all the rects, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting firtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such firtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its beirs, successors and assigns, forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully seized of the premises bereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and is lawfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except as provided berein. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagon forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

The Mortgagor further covenants and agrees as follows:

(1) That this mortgage shall secure the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs or other purposes pursuant to the covenants herein. This mortgage shall also secure the Mortgagee for any further leans, advances, rendscence or credits that may be made hereafter to the Mortgage by the Mortgagee so long as the total indulical test thus secured does not exceed the original amount shown on the face hereof. All sums so a honced shall hear interest at the sums also as the mortgage debt and chall be marable to decound of the Mortgagee unless otherwise provided in writing at the same rate as the mortgage debt and shall be payable on demand of the Mortgagee unless otherwise provided in writing

(2) That it will keep the improvements new existing or hereafter erected on the mertrared property insured as may be required from time to time by the Mertraree against loss by fire and any other hazards specified by Mertraree, in an around not less than the mertrare delet, or in such amounts as may be required by the Mertraree, and it comprises acceptable to it, and that all such pelicles and remeals thereof shall be led by the Mertraree, and have attached thereto has proable clauses in favor of, and in form any public to the Mertraree, and that it will pay held by the Mertraree, and that it does here by assent to the Mertraree the proceeds of any policy insuring the mertrared promises and does all promisms therefore each insurance company concerned to make payment for a less directly to the Mertraree, to the extent of the bilance owing on the Mortgare delet whether due or not. the Mortgige debt, whether due or not.
