MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

We, Michael T. Chandler and Iris B. Chandler, of Greenville County

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) (SEND(S) GREETINGS:

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WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIBST FEDERM, SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA chereinafter referred to as Mortgagoe's in the full and just sum of

Dollars, as evidenced by Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, which note does not contain a provision for escalation of interest rate (paragraphs 9 and 10 of this mortgage provides for an escalation of interest rate under certain

conditions), said note to be repaid with interest as the rate or rates therein specified in installments of

One Hundred Thirty-Two and 38/100----- 132,38 1 Dollars each on the first day of each month hereafter, in advance, until the principal sum with interest has been paid in full, such payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on unpaid principal balances, and then to the payment of principal with the list payment, if not sooner paid, to be due and payable -25vears after date and

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereinder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any telure to comply with and shade by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereinder shall at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, and sud-holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgages for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes insurance prenaums, repairs or for any other purpose.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgager, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgager to the Mortgager's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgager in band well and truly paid by the Mortgager at and before the scaling of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargainest, sold, and released at 1 by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgager, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate.

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of Land with all improvements thereon or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the eastern side of Rockvale Drive, being shown and designated as Lot No. 202 on a plat of Rockvale Section 2, made by J. Mac Richardson, Surveyor, dated July 1959, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book QQ at Page 109, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Rockvale Drive at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 201 and 202 and running thence along the common line of said lots, N. 87-36 E. 165 feet to an iron pin; thence along the rear line of Lot No. 181, N. 1-58 W. 75 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 202 and 203; thence along the common line of said lots, S. 87-36 W. 167.7 feet to an iron pin on Rockvale Drive; thence along the eastern side of Rockvale Drive, S. 3-49 E. 75 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner;
