To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

CHARLES BENNETT and RESIDENTIAL ENTERPRISES, INC.

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) (SEND(S) GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) in the full and just sum of

ONE HUNDRED FORTY FIVE THOUSAND ----- (\$ 145,000,00)

Dollars, as evidenced by Mortgagor's promissary note of even date herewith which note. does not contain a provision for escalation of interest rate (paragraphs 9 and 10 of this mortgage provides for an escalation of interest rate under certain

conditions), said note to be repaid with interest as the rate or rates therein specified in installments of One Thousand Three

Hundred Four and 61/100 ----- (5 1, 304, 61) Dollars each on the first day of each month hereafter, in advance, until the principal sum with interest has been parl in full, such payments to be applied first to the payment of interest computed monthly on urpaid pracipal balances, and there to the payment of principal with the last payment of not sooner paid, to be due and payable 20 years after date, and

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and impaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any fedime to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indel ted to the Mortgagee for sigh further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of times, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose,

NOW KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgager, in consideration of said dely and to secure the paying of therex f and any further some which may be advanced by the Mertgager to the Mortgager's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (Sixt) to the Mortgager in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgager it and before the scaling of these presents, the receipt whereof is bereby acknowledged, has granted, for ginest, sell and released, and by those presents does grant borgain sell and release unto the Mortgager its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina. County of Greenville, being all of Lot No. 6 and the major portion of Lot No. 7 on plat of Welcome View Subdivision made by Piedmont Engineering Service, August 1948 and recorded in plat book U at page 155 and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northeast side of White Horse Road, the joint front corner of Lots 5 & 6; thence with the northeast side of said Road S. 23-27 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence with a new line through Lot No. 7, N. 57-43 E. 222.3 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of Lots Nos. 10 & 11; thence with the rear line of said lots N. 23-27 W. 144 feet to an iron pin corner of Lot No. 5; thence with the line of said lots S. 59-13 W. 221.3 feet to the beginning corner.
