TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and angular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its heirs, successors and assigns, foreser,

The Mortgagor covenants that it is hasfully serred of the premises heremabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and is hasfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all bens and encumbrances except as herein specifically stated otherwise as follows:

This is a second mortgage being subject to that first held by Thomas & Hill.

The Mortgagor further covenants to wastant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagor forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

The Mortgagor further covenants and agrees as follows:

- (1) That this mortgage shall secure the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs or other purposes pursuant to the covenants herein. This mortgage shall also secure the Mortgagee for any further loans, advances, readvances or credits that may be made hereafter to the Mortgagee so long as the total indebtedness thus secured does not exceed the original amount shown on the face hereof. All sums so advanced shall bear interest at the same rate as the mortgage debt and shall be payable on demand of the Mortgagee unless otherwise provided in writing.
- (2) That it will keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the mortgaged property insured is may be required from time to time by the Mortgagee against loss by fire and any other hazards specified by Mortgagee, in an amount not less than the mortgage debt, or in such amounts as may be required by the Mortgagee, and in companies acceptable to it, and that all such policies and renewals thereof shall be held by the Mortgagee, and have attached thereto loss payable clauses in favor of, and in form acceptable to the Mortgagee, and that it will pay all premiums therefor when due, and that it does hereby assign to the Mortgagee the proceeds of any policy insuring the mortgaged premises and does hereby authorize each insurance company concerned to make payment for a loss directly to the Mortgagee, to the extent of the balance waing on the Mortgagee debt, whether due or not.
- (3) That it will keep all improvements now existing or hereafter erected in good repuir, and, in the case of a construction born, that it will continue construction until completion without interruption, and should it fail to do so, the Mortgager may, at its option, enter upon and premises, make whatever repuir are necessary, including the completion of any construction work underway, and charge the expenses for such repairs or the completion of such construction to the mortgager debt.
- (4) That it will pay, when due, all taxes, public assessments, and other governmental or municipal charges, lines or other impositions against the mortgaged premises. That it will comply with all governmental and municipal laws and regulations affecting the mortgaged promises.
