All that certain poece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 125 of a subdivision known as Pebble Creek, Phase I as shown on plat thereof prepared by Enwright Associates, Engineers, dated October 1973, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 5-D at Page 3 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeastern side of Stalling Road, joint front corner of Lots 125 and 126; running thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 53-48 E. 174.1 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot 129; thence with the rear lines of Lots 129 and 130, S. 34-30 W. 112 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 124 and 125; thence with the joint line of said lots, N. 55-09 W. 174.7 feet to an iron pin on the southeastern side of Stalling Road, joint front corner of Lots 124 and 125; thence with the southeastern side of Stalling Road, N. 34-46 E. 110 feet to the point of beginning;
