State of South Carolina; on the Southeastern side of Flora Avenue, and being known and designated as the southern portion of Lot No. 68 on Plat entitled CAMILLA PARK, Map 2, prepared by W. J. Riddle, December 1943, recorded in Plat Book "M", at Pages 84 and 85 in the Office of the RMC for Greenville County, South Carolina, and having, according to said Plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
