"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of GREENVILLE, Fairview Township, as shown on a Plat prepared by John E. Woods, R.L.S., on Frebruary 2, 1972, said Plat entitled "Plat of Property of Frances N. and Michael E. Taylor", and having, according to said Plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a nail and cap in the center of the Hickory Taver, Road, and running S. 37-24 W. along line of land now or formerly of C. G. Powers, 592.3 ft. to an iron pin, joint corner with Powers land and other lands of Neves; thence N. 41-19 W., 150.8 ft. to an iron pin, corner with other lands of Neves; thence N. 37-15 E., 592.6 ft. along line of other lands of Neves to a nail and cap in the center of the Hickory Taver Road, crossing an iron pin 33 ft. from the center of the Road; thence along the center of the Hickory Taver Road, S. 41-19 E., 152.4 ft. to a nail and cap, the point of beginning, being bounded by lands of C.
