NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is bereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, located, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina in Bates Township on the northwestern side of McElhaney Road, containing 21 acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of McElhaney Road at the cormer of the 90 acre tract heretofore conveyed by Fred R. Roach to the Brandon Corporation and running thence along the center of said McElhaney Road, S. 67-O5 W. 149 feet, more or less, to a bend in said road; thence still with the center of said road, S. 23-1/2 W. 394 feet, more or less, to a point in the center of said road at the corner of property now or formerly belonging to Charlie Batson; thence along the line of the Batson property N. 35-1/2 W. 2,078.38 feet, more or less, to a stake at the corner of the 90 acre tract of the Brandon Corporation; thence along the line of the Brandon tract, N. 60-20 E. 489 feet to the corner of the Brandon Tract; thence still with the line of the Brandon tract, S. 35-30 E. 1,780 feet to the beginning corner in the center of the McElhaney Road.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its heirs, successors and assigns, forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and is lawfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except as provided berein. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

The Mortgagor further covenants and agrees as follows:

(1) That this mortgage shall secure the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs or other purposes pursuant to the covenants herein. This mortgage shall also secure the Mortgagee for any further loans, advances, readvances or credits that may be made hereafter to the Mortgager by the Mortgagee so long as the total indebtedness thus secured does not exceed the original amount shown on the face hereof. All sums so advanced shall bear interest at the same rate as the mortgage debt and shall be payable on demand of the Mortgagee unless otherwise provided in writing.

(2) That it will keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the mortgaged property insured as may be required from time to time by the Mortgagee against loss by fire and any other hazards specified by Mortgagee, in an amount not less than the mortgage debt, or in such amounts as may be required by the Mortgagee, and in companies acceptable to it, and that all such policies and recrewals thereof shall be held by the Mortgagee, and therefore have attached thereto loss payable clauses in favor of, and in form acceptable to the Mortgagee, and that it will pay all premiums therefor when due; and that it does hereby assign to the Mortgagee the proceeds of any policy insuring the mortgaged premises and does hereby authorize each insurance company concerned to make payment for a loss directly to the Mortgagee, to the extent of the balance owing on the Mortgage debt, whether due or not.

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
