All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of Lind, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Butler Township, on the northeastern side of Rolling Green Circle and being more particularly shown as Lot 4 containing 3.7 acres on a plat of Rolling Green Real Estate Company made by J. Q. Bruce, dated August 24, 1961 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book XX at Page 33 and being described as follows:
