NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and as-

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with ail improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville

All that certain parcel or lot of land situate on the north side of Lancaster Avenue and on the east side of Brockman Street in the City of Greer, Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being the greater portion of Lot No. 98 of the W. H. Brockman Estate, plat thereof being recorded in Plat Book H at Page 132 in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and being more particularly designated and shown as the property of Charles E. Eledge, according to a survey and plat thereof by Robert E. Jordon, Surveyor, dated January 17, 1955, recorded in Plat Book FF at Page 256 in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County and having a uniform depth of 150 feet and a uniform width of 70 feet. Reference is hereby made to said later plat for a more complete description.
