The Mortgagor represents and warrants that said Mortgagor is solvent at the time of making this instrument and will at all times during the above described period be free and clear of all liens or charges upon the property, except the Mortgagor's interest therein, and that he will survey or cause to be surveyed the same, and that the Mortgagor will place a notice of his claim upon the property, and will sue for damages from and against the Mortgagor and every person who may have lost his or her claim by reason of the nonpayment of the sum of money.
