All these conditions, as well as the presence of small flocks of  
other birds, were favorable to the development of the nestling. It is usually  
the case that nestlings of small species do not last 4-  
5 days, but here it was 10 days. The bird lay 12 eggs, and re-  
mained on the nest during the whole time of incubation.  
The bird was seen to visit the nest only twice a day.

REVIEW - An examination of the evidence adduced in this trial, at the first stages of both B and C, in the W., and compares thence with that of the B trial, particularly in respect of the manner in which the few witnesses called by the defense were cross-examined, and in the way the Court in particular, after the B trial, dealt with those of the S trial who were similarly cross-examined. It will be seen from this review that the defense was not given the opportunity of fully dealing with the evidence adduced in the B trial.
