

**TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** all and singular the said premises to the M<sup>r</sup> John C. Edwards and wife  
forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that he is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that he has good right and lawful authority to sell, convey, encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances whatsoever. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises unto the Mortgagor forever from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

The Mortgagor covenants and agrees as follows.

- That he will promptly pay the principal of and interest on the indebtedness evidenced by the said note at the time and in the manner therein provided, or as modified or extended by mutual agreement in writing.
  - That this mortgage shall secure the Mortgagor for such further sums as may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or other purposes pursuant to the covenants herein, and also any further loans, advances, renewances or credits that may be made hereafter to the Mortgagor by the Mortgagor, and for any other or further obligation or indebtedness due to the Mortgagee by the Mortgagor at any time hereafter, and that all sums so advanced shall bear interest at the same rate as the Mortgage debt and shall be payable on demand of the Mortgagee, unless otherwise provided in writing; and the lien of this mortgage securing such advances and renewances shall be superior to the rights of the holder of any intervening lien or encumbrance.
  - Without affecting the liability of any person obligated for the payment of any indebtedness secured hereby, and without affecting the rights of the Mortgagee with respect to any security not expressly released in writing, the Mortgagee may at any time, without notice or consent, make any agreement extending the time or otherwise altering the terms of payment of the indebtedness secured hereby.
  - That he will keep the improvements now existing upon the land or the mortgaged property named as may be required from time to time by the Mortgagee, in accordance with usual standards of quality and workmanship in such amounts and to such periods of time as may be required by the Mortgagee, and will pay promptly when due all premiums upon the insurance, and all taxes and assessments levied thereon. All such tax shall be paid by the Mortgagor, and the expenses of collection thereof shall be paid by the Mortgagor, and by him at his sole cost and expense, and in form acceptable to the Mortgagee. In event of loss, Mortgagor shall be liable to the Mortgagee who may make good of loss at cost and expense to the Mortgagee, and the sum so expended is hereby authorized and directed to be recovered from the funds of the Mortgagor held by the Mortgagee and Mortgagor jointly, and the amount so expended or recovered shall be applied to the Mortgagee at its option, either to the reduction of the indebtedness hereby created, or to the payment of the costs of the property damaged. In event of foreclosure of this mortgage, or the sale of the property, the Mortgagee's right of recovery of the indebtedness so used shall be limited to the amount of the Mortgage, and the same shall be paid as follows: then in force shall pass to the purchaser of record:
  - That he will keep all improvements now existing or hereafter erected upon the mortgaged property in good repair, and, in the case of a construction loan, that he will continue construction until completion without interruption, and should he fail to do so, the Mortgagee may, at its option, enter upon said premises, make whatever repairs are necessary, including the completion of any construction work underway, and charge the expenses for such repairs to the completion of such construction to the mortgage debt.
  - That the Mortgagee may require the maker, co-maker or endorser of any indebtedness secured hereby to carry life insurance upon himself in a sum sufficient to pay all sums secured by this mortgage, designating the Mortgagee as beneficiary thereof, and, upon failure of the Mortgagor to pay the premiums therefor, the Mortgagee may, at its option, pay said premiums, and all sums so advanced by the Mortgagor shall become a part of mortgage debt.
  - That, together with, and in addition to, the monthly payments of principal and interest payable under the terms of the note secured hereby, he will pay to the Mortgagor, on the first day of each month, until the indebtedness secured hereby is paid in full, a sum equal to one-twelfth of the annual taxes, public assessments and insurance premiums, as estimated by the Mortgagee, and, on the failure of the Mortgagor to pay all taxes, insurance premiums and public assessments, the Mortgagee may at its option, pay said items and charge all advances therefor to the mortgage debt. These monthly extra payments will not bear interest to the mortgagor.
  - That he hereby assigns all the rents, issues, and profits of the mortgaged premises from and after any default hereunder, and should legal proceedings be instituted pursuant to this instrument, then the Mortgagee shall have the right to have a receiver appointed of the rents, issues, and profits, who, after deducting all charges and expenses attending such proceedings and the execution of his trust as receiver, shall apply the residue of the rents, issues, and profits, toward the payment of the debt secured hereby.
  - That, at the option of the Mortgagee, this mortgage shall become due and payable forthwith if the Mortgagor shall convey away said mortgaged premises, or if the title shall become vested in any other person in any manner whatsoever other than by death of the Mortgagor, or, in the case of a construction loan, if the Mortgagor shall permit work on the project to become and remain interrupted for a period of fifteen (15) days without the written consent of the Mortgagee.
  - It is agreed that the Mortgagor shall hold and enjoy the premises above conveyed until there is a default under this mortgage or in the note secured hereby. It is the true meaning of this instrument that if the Mortgagor shall fully perform all the terms, conditions, and covenants of this mortgage, and of the note secured hereby, that then this mortgage shall be utterly null and void; otherwise to remain in full force and virtue. If there is a default in any of the terms, conditions or covenants of this mortgage, or of the note secured hereby, then, at the option of the Mortgagee, all sums then owing by the Mortgagor to the Mortgagee shall become immediately due and payable and this mortgage may be foreclosed. Should any legal proceedings be instituted for the foreclosure of this mortgage, or should the Mortgagor become a party to any suit involving this Mortgage or the title to the premises described herein, or should the debt secured hereby or any part thereof be placed in the hands of an attorney at law for collection by suit or otherwise, all costs and expenses incurred by the Mortgagee, and a reasonable attorney's fee, shall thereupon become due and payable immediately or on demand, at the option of the Mortgagee, as a part of the debt secured thereby, and may be recovered and collected hereunder.
