A short time ago the author had the opportunity to see the benefits of insulation in a house built by the State of South Carolina at Greenville.

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of Cunningham Road, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 56 and 57, and running thence with the joint line of said lots, N. 81-26 W. 169.4 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 47 and continuing with the line of Lot No. 48, N. 7-37 E. 110 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 55 and 56; thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 81-28 E. 172.4 feet to an iron pin on the western side of Cunningham Road; thence with said road, S. 8-49 W. 110 feet to the beginning corner.
