NOW, KNOW ALL MEN. That the said Morreagor, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms and tenor of said note, and also in consideration of THREE (\$3.00) DOLLARS to them in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Morreagee, all that trace or lot of land lying, being and situated

All that, piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Greenville, Township, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of the New Easley Road, 17 feet from the edge of the pavement at the corner of land previously sold by H.K. Townes to J.B. Spearman, and running thence along the side of said road 17 feet from the edge of the pavement and parallel with same, N.75-35E. 116 feet to an iron pin; thence S.13E. 435 feet to an iron pin across branch; thence N.72 M. 135 feet recrossing branch to iron pin; thence N. 13 M. 370.5 feet to beginning corner, containing 1.07 acres, more or less, as surveyed by M.J. Riddle, September 1940

TOGETHER WITH all and singular the ways, easements, tiparian and other rights, and all renoments, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and all buildings, structures and other improvements now on said land or that hereafter may be erected or placed thereon, and all fixtures attached thereto and all rents, income, issues and profits accruing and to accrue therefrom.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described property unto Morrgagee, his heirs, successors, and assigns forever.

Mortgagor bereby covenants with Mortgagee that Mortgagor is indeteasibly seized with the absolute and fee simple title to said property; that Mortgagor has full power and lawful authority to sell, convey, assign, transfer and mortgage the same; that it shall be lawful for Mortgagee at any time hereafter peaceably and quietly to enter upon, have, hold and entry said property and every part thereof; that said property is free and discharged from all liens, encumbrances and claims of every kind, including all raxes and assessments, that Mortgagor will, at his own expense, make such other and further instruments and assurances to vest absolute and tee simple title to said property in Mortgagee that may be requested by Mortgagee; and that Mortgagor will, and his heirs, legal representatives and successors shall, warrant and defend the title to said property unto Mortgagee against the lawful claims and demands of all persons who mosever

PROVIDED ALWAYS, and these presents are upon these express conditions, that it the said Mortgagor shall promptly, well and truly pay to the Mortgagor the said debt or sum of money aforesaid, according to the true intent and tenor of said note, and until full payment thereof, or any extensions or renewals thereof in whole or in part, and payment of all other in ebredness or liability that may become due and owing hereunder and secured hereby, shall faithfully and promptly comply with and perform each and every other covenant and provision herein on the part of the Mortgagor to be complied with and performed, then this deed of barcain and sale shall cease, determine, and be utterly void; otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.

And Mortgagor hereby covenants as follows

To keep the buildings, structures and other in power lents new or herester erected or placed on the premises insured in an amount not less than the principal amount of the note aforesaid against all loss or damage by fire, windstorm, tornado and water damage, as may be required by the Mortgagee, with loss, if any, payable to the Mortgagee as his interest may appear, to deposit with the Mortgagee policies with standard mortgagee clause, without contribution, evidencing such insurence, to keep said premises and all improvements thereon in first class condition and repair. In case of loss, Mortgagee in hereby authorized to adjust and settle any claim under any such policy and Mortgagee is authorized to collect and receipt for any such insurance money and to apply the same at Mortgagee's option, in reduction of the indebtedness hereby secured, whether due or not, or to allow Mortgager to use such insurance money, or the part thereof, in repairing the damage or restoring the improvements or other property without affecting the lien he cof for the full amount secured hereby.

It is further covenanted that Mortifacte may thur shall not be obligated so to do) advance moneys that should have been paid by Mortgagot hereunder in order to protect the lien or security hereof, and Mortgagot agrees without demand to forthwith repay such moneys, which amount shall bear interest from the date so advanced until paid at the rate of six per cost 1600, per annum and shall be considered as so much additional indebtedness secured hereby; but no payment by Mortgagee of any such moneys shall be deemed a waiver of Mortgagee's right to declare the principal sum due hereunder by reason of the default or violation of Mortgagot in any of his covenants hereunder.

Mortragor further covenants that granting any extension or extensions of the time payment of any part or all of the total indebtedness or liability secured hereby, or taking other or additional security for payment thereof, shall not affect this mortrage or the rights of Morrigagee hereunder, or operate as a release from any liability upon any part of the indebtedness hereby secured, under any covenant herein contained













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
