TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or apportaining, including all built-in stoves and refrigerators, heating, air conditioning, plumbing and electrical fixtures, wall to wall carpeting, fences and gates, and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached connected or litted in any mainter, it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than household immature, be considered a part of the realty.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises unto the Mortzagee, its successors and assigns forever.

The Mortgagor represents and warrants that said Mortgagor is seized of the above described premises in tee simple absolute, that the above described premises are free and clear of all liens or other encumbrances; that the Mortgagor is lawfully empowered to convey or encumber the same, and that the Mortgagor will forever defend the said premises unto the Mortgagor, its successors and assigns, from and against the Mortgagor and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

## THE MORIGAGOR COVENANTS AND AGREES AS FOLLOWS:

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- 1. That the Mortgagor will promptly pay the principal and interest on the indebtedness evidenced by said promissory note at the times and in the manner therein provided.
- 2. That this mortgage will secure the Mortgagee for any additional sums which may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, or public assessments, hazard insurance premiums, repairs or other such purposes pursuant to the provisions of this mortgage, and also for any loans or advances that may hereafter be made by the Mortgagee to the Mortgager under the authority of Sec. 45-55, 1962 Code of laws of South Carolina, as amended, or similar statutes, and all soms so advanced shall bear interest at the same rate or rates as that provided in said note unless otherwise agreed upon by the parties and shall be payable at the demand of the Mortgagee, unless otherwise provided in writing.
- 3. That Mortgagor will keep the improvements on the mortgaged premises, whether now existing or hereafter to be erected, insured against loss by fire, windstorm and other hazards in a sum not less than the balance due hereinder at any time and in a company or companies acceptable to the Mortgagee, and Mortgagor does hereby assign the policy or policies of insurance to the Mortgagee and agrees that all such policies shall be held by the Mortgagee should it so require and shall include loss payable clauses in favor of the Mortgagee, and in the event of loss, Mortgagor will give inanceliate notice thereof to the Mortgagee by registered in al. and should the Mortgagor at any time fail to keep said premises insured or fail to pay the premiums for such insurance, then the Mortgagee may cause such improvements to be insured in the name of the Mortgagor and reimburse itself for the cost of such insurance, with interest as hereinabove provided.
- 4. That the Mortgagor will keep all improvements upon the mortgaged premises in good repair, and should Mortgagor fail to do so, the Mortgagee may at its option, enter upon said premises and make whatever repairs are necessary and charge the expenses for such repairs to the mortgage debt and collect the same under this mortgage, with interest as hereinabove provided.
- 5. That the Mortzagee may at any time respire the issuance and maintenance of insurance upon the life of any person obligated under the indebtedness secured hereby in a sum sufficient to pay the mortgage debt, with the Mortgagee as beneficiary, and if the premiums are not otherwise paid, the Mortgagee may pay said premiums and any amount so paid shall become a part of the mortgage debt.
- 6. That Mortgagor regrees to pay all taxes and other public assessments levied against the mortgaged premises on or before the due dates thereof and to exhibit the receipts therefor at the offices of the Mortgagor minediately upon payment, and should the Mortgagor fail to pay such taxes and assessments when the same shall fall due, the Mortgagee may, at its option pay the same and charge the amounts so paid to the mortgage debt and collect the same under this mortgage, with interest as above provided.
- 7. That if this inortrage secures a "construction loan", the Mortrager agrees that the principal amount of the indebtedness hereby secured shall be disbursed to the Mortragor in periodic payments, as construction progresses, in accordance with the terms and conditions of a Construction Loan Agreement which is separately executed but is made a part of this mortgage and incorporated herein by reference.
- S. That the Mortgagor will not further encounter the precises above described, without the prior consent of the Mortgagoe, and should the Mortgagor so encounter such premises the Mortgagor may at its option, declare the indebtedness hereby secured to be immediately due and payable and may institute any proceedings necessary to collect said indebtedness.
- 9. That should the Mortgagor alienate the mortgaged premises by Contract of Sale Bond for Title, or Deed of Conveyance, and the within mortgage indebtedness is not paid in full, the Mortgagor or his Purchaser shall be required to file with the Association an application for an assumption of the mortgage indebtedness, pay the reasonable cost as required by the Association for processing the assumption furnish the Association with a copy of the Contract of Sale, Bond for Title, or Deed of Conveyance, and have the interest rate on the loan bidance existing at the time of transfer modified by its reasonable to the said loan balance to the maximum rate per animum permitted to be charged at that time by applicable South Circlina law, or a lesser increase in interest rate as may be determined by the Association. The Association will notify the Mortgagor or his purchaser of the new interest rate and monthly payments and will mad him a new pissbook. Should the Mortgagor, or his Furchaser, full to comply with the provisions of the within paragraph, the Mortgagor at its option may declare the indebtedness barely second to be rained intelly due and payable and may institute any proceedings racessary to collect said indebtedness.
- 10. That should the Mortgagor ful to make payments of principal and interest as disc on the promissory rate and the same shall be unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days or if there should be any full reto comply with and shalle by any by-laws or the charter of the Mortgagor, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the Mortgagor at its option may write to the Mortgagor at his list known address giving him thirty (30) days in which to rectify the suil default and should the Mortgagor ful to rectify said default within the said thirty days, the Mortgagor, may at its option, more use the interest rate on the loan balance for the remaining term of the loan or for a lesser term to the maximum rate per anomic permitted to be charged at that time by applicable South Carolina law, or a lesser increase rate as may be determined by the Association. The monthly payments will be adjusted accordingly.
- 11. That should the Mortz cor fail to mobe presents of principal and interest is due on the promissory rate and should any monthly installment become past due for a period in excess of 15 days, the Mortz izer may collect a "late charze" not to exceed an amount equal to five (5%) per centum of any such past due installment in order to cover the extra expense incident to the handling of such delinquent payments.
- 12. That the Mortgagor hereby assigns to the Mortgagee, its six essers and issigns all the rents issues and profits accroing from the mortgaged premises retaining the right to collect the same so long is the debt hereby secretal is not in arrears of payment, but should any part of the principal indebtedness, or interest, tixes, or far insurance premiums, he past due and impaid the Mortgagee may without notice or further proceedings take over the mortgaged premises, if they shall be occopied by a terrant or terrant collect said rents and profits and apply the same to the indebtudies hardly secured, without hiddly to account for anything more than the rents and profits actually collected, less the cost of collection and any terrant is authorized upon request by Mortgagee, to make all rental payments direct to the Mortgage without hiddly to the Mortgager until notified to the contrary by the Mortgagee, and should said premises at the time of such defuilt be occupied by the Mortgager, into Mortgager may apply to the Indige of the County Court or to any Indige of the Court of Common Pleas who shall be resident or presiding in the county aforesaid for the appointment of a receiver with authority to take possession of said premises and collect such rents and profits actually collected.
- 13. That the Mortgagee, at its option, may require the Mortgagor to pay to the Mortgagee, on the first day of each month until the note secured hereby is fully paid, the following sums in addition to the payments of principal and interest provided in said note: a sum equal to the premiums that will next become due and payable on policies of mortgage guaranty usur unce (if applicable), fire and other hazard insurance covering the mortgaged property, plus taxes, and assessments next due on the mortgaged principes (all as estimated by the Mortgagee) less all sums already paid therefor, divided by the number of morths to close before one morth prior to the date when such premiums taxes and assessments will be due and payable, such some to be held by Mortgagee one mortal prior to the date when insurance premiums. Should these payments exceed the amount of payments actually made by the Mortgagee for taxes, assessments, or insurance premiums, the excess may be credited by the Mortgagee on subsequent payments to be made by the Mortgagor, if, however, said sums shall be insufficient to make said payments when the same shall become due and payable, the Mortgagor shall pay to the Mortgagee may amounts necessary to make up the deficiency. The Mortgagor further agrees that at the end of ten years from the date hereof.
