SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, Carroll W. Pitman and June S. Pitman the said certain promissory note in writing of even date with these Presents, well in and by and truly indebted unto the CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, Greer, S. C., in the full and just sum of Twenty Nine Thousand and No/100 ----- (\$ 29.000.00 ) Dollars, with interest from the date hereof at the rate of eight 3/4 per cent (8 3/26) per annum, unpaid interest to bear interest at the same rate, to be repaid in installments of Two Hundred Fifty Six and 28/100 --due and payable on the 5th day of each and every calendar month hereafter until the full principal sum, with interest

C., according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) the said mortgagor\_s in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee, at and Dollars to before the sealing and delivery of these Presents (receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Crrizens Building and LOAN Association, Greer, S. C., its successors and assigns:

That certain lot, parcel or tract of land, with all improvements now constructed thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina. County of Greenville. Butler Township, located on the east side of a county road near the Village of Pelham, and being shown on the plat of property made for Mrs. Ethel Pittman by H. S. Brockman, surveyor, dated March 4, 1952, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book BB, page 25, and having the collowing courses and distances: (Lot No. 10)

BEGINNING on an iron pin on the margin of said county road, joint corner with Tracts Nos. 9 and 10 on said plat, and runs thence along the margin of said road, S. 16-18 E. 111.5 feet to stake, S. 29-50 E. 340 feet to a stake, and S. 40-55 E. 300 feet to a point in the center of branch; thence up and with the meanders of said branch as the line as follows; N. 9-31 W. 346 feet to stake, N. 29-40 E. 186 feet, N. 11-53 E. 80.5 feet and N. 30 W. 121.5 feet (stake on west bank of branch at 17 feet); thence S. 82 W. 384 feet to the beginning, containing 3.45 acres, more or less.
