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topether with all rights, interests, essements, herediaments and appurenances thereunto belonging, the rents, issues, and profits thereof and revenues and income therefrom, all improvements and personal property now or later attached thereto or reasonably necessary to the use thereof, including, but not limited to, ranges, refrigerators, clothes washers, clothes dryers, or carpeting purchased or financed in whole or in part with loan funds. all water, water rights, and water stock pertaining thereto, and all payments at any time owing to Borrower by sixtue of any sale, lease, transfer, consequence, or condemnation of any part thereof or interest therein-all of which are herein called "the property":

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the property unto the Government and its assigns forever in fee simple

BORROWER for himself, his hear, executors, administrators, successors and essigns WARRANTS THE TITLE to the property to the Government against all faultil claims and demands whitsomer except any liens, encumbrances, easements, reservations, or conveyances specified hereinabove, and COVENANTS AND AGREES as follows:

- (1) To pay promptly when due any indebtedness to the Government hereby secured and to indemnify and save harmless the Government against any loss under its insurance of payment of the note by reason of any defarts of Borrower. At all times when the note is held by an insured holder, Borrower shall continue to make payments on the note to the Governo path, as collection agent for the holder.
- (2) To pay to the Government such fees and other charges as rise now or hereafter be required by regulations of the Farmers Home Administration.
- (3) If required by the Government, to make additional mostly payments , 1/12 of two estimated annual taxes, assessments, insurance premiums and other charges upon the mortgaged premises.
- (4) Whether or not the note is insured by the Government, if the interment may at any time pay any other amounts required herein to be publicly. Borrower and not paid by him when due, as well as any more a dexpenses for the preservation, a conference of this lies, as advances for the account of Borrower. All such advances shall and link not at the rate borne by the note which has the highest interest rate.
- (5) All advances by the Government as described in this kindiment, with interest, shall be immediately due and payable by Bostower to the Government without demand at the place designated in the intest note and shall be secured hereby. No such advances by the Government shall rehere. Bostower from breach of his covenant to 1 co. Any payment made by Bostower may be applied on the note or any indebtedness to the Government secured hereby, in any order the payment determines.
 - (6) To use the loan evidenced by the note solely for purpose anythorized by the Government.
- (7) To pay when due all taxes, liens, judgments, encumbran s—and assessments lawfully attaching to or assessed against the property and promptly deliver to the Government without demand receipts such payments.
 - (5) To keep the property insured as required by and under a second policies approved by delivered to, and retained by the Government.

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
