WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and shide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Morteagee, or any stipulations set out in this morteage, the whole amount due thereunder shall at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for proceedings; and

C., being known and designated as Lot No. 153, on plat entitled "Map No. 4, Section One, Sugar Creek" as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book 5D, at Page 72, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northwesterly side of Middle Brook Road, said pin being the joint front corner of Lots 152 and 153 and running thence N. 38-41-10 W. 145.35 feet to an iron pin, the joint rear corner of Lots 152 and 153; thence S. 50-56-34 W. 147 feet to an iron pin, the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 153 and 154; thence with the common line of said Lots S. 64-11-34 E. 138.04 feet to an iron pin on the northwesterly side of Middle Brook Road; thence with the northwesterly side of Middle Brook Road on a curve the chord of which is N. 59-07-56 E. 54.94 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with Middle Brook Road on a curve the chord of which is N. 71-45-08 E. 35.36 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
