TOGETHE's with all and singular the rights, members bereditations and appenditure ces to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertuning, incloding all builton stoves and refrigerators, beat on an even intenting plumbing and closured features will to will corporate, fences and pates and any other equipment or fixtures now or bereafter attached connected or fitted in any promer, at being the intention of the parties bereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than household function, be considered a part of the realty.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns forever.

The Mortgagor represents and warrants that said Mortgagor is seized of the above described premises in fee simple absolute, that the above described premises are free and clear of all bets or other examinations, that the Mortgagor is lawfully empowered to convey or encumber the same, and that the Mortgagor will forever defend the said premises unto the Mortgagor, its successors and assigns, from and against the Mortgagor and every person whomsoever lawfully climing or to claim the same or any part thereof.

THE MORTGACOR COVENANTS AND AGREES AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the Mortgagor will promptly pay the principal and interest on the indebtedness evidenced by said promissory note at the times and in the manner therein provided.
- 2. That this mortgage will secure the Mortgagee for any additional sums which may be advanced bereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, or public assessments, hazard insurance premiums, repairs or other such purposes pursuant to the provinces of this mortgage, and also for any lears or advances that may be reafter be made by the Mortgagee to the Mortgager under the authority of Sec. 45-55, 1962 Code of laws of South Carolina, as amended, or similar statutes; and all sums so advanced shall be interest at the same rate or rates as that provided in said note unless otherwise agreed upon by the parties and shall be payable at the demand of the Mortgagee, unless otherwise provided in writing.
- 3. That Mortgagor will keep the improvements on the mortgaged premises, whether now existing or hereafter to be erected, insured against loss by fire, windstorm and other hazards in a sum not less than the balance due hereunder at any time and in a company or companies acceptable to the Mortgagor, and Mortgagor does hereby assign the policy or policies of insurance to the Mortgagor and agrees that all such policies shall be held by the Mortgagor should it so require and shall include loss payable clauses in favor of the Mortgagor, and in the event of loss, Mortgagor will give immediate notice thereof to the Mortgagor by registered mail, and should the Mortgagor at any time fail to keep said premises insured or fail to pay the premiums for such insurance, then the Mortgagor may cause such improvements to be insured in the name of the Mortgagor and reinfinise itself for the cost of such insurance, with interest as hereinabove provided.
- 4. That the Mortgagor will keep all improvements upon the mortgaged premises in good repair, and should Mortgagor fail to do so, the Mortgagor may, at its option, enter upon said premises and make whatever require are necessary and charge the expenses for such repairs to the mortgage debt and collect the same under this mortgage, with interest as hereinabove provided.
- 5. That the Mortgagee may at any time require the issuance and maintenance of insurance upon the life of any person oldigated under the indebtedness secured hereby in a sum sufficient to pay the mortgage debt, with the Mortgagee is beneficiary, and if the premiums are not otherwise paid, the Mortgagee may pay said premiums and any amount so paid shall become a part of the mortgage debt.
- 6. That Mortgagor agrees to pay all taxes and other public assessments levied against the mortgaged premises on or before the due dates thereof and to exhibit the receipts therefor at the offices of the Mortgagor minimalisticly upon payment, and should the Mortgagor fail to pay such taxes and assessments when the same shall fall due, the Mortgagor may, at its option pay the same and charge the amounts so paid to the mortgage debt and collect the same under this mortgage, with interest as above provided.
- 7. That if this meetgage secures a "construction foun", the Meetgager agrees that the janusipal amount of the indebtodness hereby secured shall be disloured to the Meetgager in periodic payments, as construction progresses, in accordance with the terms and conditions of a Construction Loan Agreement which is separately executed but is made a part of this mortgage and incorporated herein by reference.
- S. That the Mesterges will not further encumber the premises alone described, without the prior consent of the Mestgages, and should the Mestgages so encumber such premises, the Mestgages may, at its option, declare the indebtedness hereby secured to be immediately due and payable and may institute any proceedings necessary to collect and indebtedness.
- 9. That should the Mortgagor alierate the mortgaged premises by Contract of Sale, Bond for Tale, or Deed of Conveyance, and the within mortgage indebtedness is not paid in full, the Mortgagor or his Furchaser shall be required to file with the Association an application for an assumption of the mortgage indebtedness, pay the reasonable cost as required by the Association for processing the assumption, furnish the Association with a copy of the Contract of Sale, Bond for Table, or Deed of Conveyance, and have the interest rate on the lean balance easting at the time of trainfer modified by increasing the interest rate on the said loan balance to the maximum rate per annum permitted to be charged at that time by applicable South Cardina law, or a lesser increase in interest rate as may be determined by the Association. The Association will notify the Mortgagor or his purchaser of the new interest rate and monthly payments, and will mail him a new passbook. Should the Mortgagor, or his Purchaser, fail to comply with the provisions of the within paragraph, the Mortgagoe, at its option, may declare the indebtedness hereby secured to be immediately due and payable and may institute any proceedings necessary to collect and indebtedness.
- 10. That should the Mortgagor full to make payments of principal and interest as due on the promissery note and the same shall be unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days or if there should be any failure to comply with and alode by any by-laws or the charter of the Mortgagor, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the Mortgagor at its option may write to the Mortgagor at his last known address giving him thirty (30) days in which to rectify the said default and should the Mortgagor fail to rectify said default within the said thirty days, the Mortgagor, may, at its option, increase the interest rate on the loan belance for the remaining term of the loan for a lesser term to the maximum rate per amount permitted to be charged at that time by applicable South Carolina law, or a lesser increase rate as may be determined by the Association. The monthly payments will be adjusted accordingly.
- 11. That should the Mortgagor fail to make payments of principal and interest as due on the promisory note and should any morably installment become past due for a period in excess of 15 days, the Mortgagor may collect a "late charge" not to exceed an amount equal to five (5%) per centum of any such past due installment in order to cover the extra expense incident to the handling of such delinquent payments.
- 12. That the Mortgagor hereby assigns to the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns, all the rents, issues, and profits accruing from the mortgaged premises, retaining the right to collect the same so long as the delet hereby secured is not in arrears of payment, but should any part of the priscipal indebtedness, or interest, taxes, or fire insurance premiums, he past due and suspaid, the Mortgagor may without richies or further proceedings take over the mortgaged premises, if they shall be occupied by a ternant or tenants, and collect said tents and profits and apply the same to the indebtedness hereby secured, without liability to account for anything more than the rents and profits actually collected, less the cost of collection and any tenant is authorized upon request by Mortgagoe, to make all rental payments direct to the Mortgagoe without liability to the Mortgagoe until morfied to the contrary by the Mortgagoe, and should said premises at the time of such default be occupied by the Mortgagon, the Mortgagoe may apply to the Judge of the County Court or to any Judge of the Court of Common Pleas who shall be resident or presiding in the county aforesaid for the appointment of a receiver with authority to take possession of said premises and collect such rents and profits, applying said rents, after paying the cost of collection, to the mortgage delat without liability to account for anything more than the rents and profits actually collected.
- 13. That the Mortgagee, at its option, may require the Mortgagor to pay to the Mortgagoe, on the first day of each month until the note secured hereby is fully paid, the following sums in addition to the payments of principal and interest provided in said rote: a sum equal to the premiums that will next become due and payable on policies of mortgage guaranty insurance (if applicable), fire and other hazard insurance covering the mortgaged property: plus taxes, and assessments next due on the mortgaged premiues (all as estimated by the Mortgagee) less all sums aheady paid therefor, divided by the number of months to clause before one month prior to the date when such premiums, taxes, and assessments will be due and payable, such sums to be held by Mortgagee to pay said premiums, taxes and special assessments. Should these payments exceed the amount of payments actually made by the Mortgagor for taxes, assessments, or insurance premiums, the excess may be credited by the Mortgagee on subsequent payments to be made by the Mortgagor, it, however, said sums shall be insufficient to make said payments when the same shall become due and payable, the Mortgagor shall pay to the Mortgagee any amounts necessary to make up the deficiency. The Mortgagor further agrees that at the end of ten years from the date bereof, Mortgagee may, at its option, apply for renewal of mortgage guaranty or similar insurance (if applicable) covering the balance then remaining due on the mortgage debt, and the Mortgagor may, at its option, pay the single premium required for the remaining years of the term, or the Mortgagoe may pay such premium and add the same to the mortgage debt, in equal monthly installments over the remaining payment period.

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
