WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and ampaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and shide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage: the whole amount due thereunder shall at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure some, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagoe for such further same as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes insurance premiums, repairs or for any other purpose.

W. ALEXANDER, made by T. Craig Keith, Surveyor, dated July 13, 1965, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book LLL at page 41, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Angie Drive at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2 and running thence with the eastern side of said Drive, S. 9-55 E., 270.7 feet to an iron pin in the line of property now or formerly belonging to Brushy Creek School; thence with the line of Brushy Creek School, N. 25-00 E., 158.5 feet to a stone; thence S. 78-45 E., 132 feet to a hickory tree; thence N. 15-29 W., 161.8 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2; thence along the common line of said lots, S. 88-00 W., 200 feet to an iron pin on the eastern side of Angie Drive, the point of beginning.
