All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, about seven (7) miles southwest of the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 33 B which is a portion of Lot No. 33 of the property of William R. Timmons, Jr. as shown on a plat recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 000 at page 193 and which is also shown on a more recent plat of the property of James E.
