

3. That, together with, and in addition to, the monthly payments of principal and interest payable under the terms of the note secured hereby, he will pay to the Mortgagor, on the tenth day of each month, until the said note is fully paid, the following sums:

A. An amount sufficient to pay the taxes, assessments, insurance premiums, and other governmental charges, including the cost of collection, levied or assessed against the property, or the part thereof, held by the Mortgagor, and the National Housing Agency, and Urban Development Corporation, respectively.

B. If and so long as such taxes, assessments, insurance premiums, and other governmental charges, or any part thereof, shall not be paid when due, the amount of such taxes, assessments, insurance premiums, and other governmental charges, or any part thereof, plus interest thereon at the rate of six percent per annum from the date when such taxes, assessments, insurance premiums, and other governmental charges, or any part thereof, become delinquent, up to the date of payment to the Mortgagor, in trust, for payment and cancellation of such taxes, assessments, insurance premiums, and other governmental charges, or any part thereof.

C. If, if and so long as such taxes, assessments, insurance premiums, and other governmental charges, or any part thereof, shall not be paid when due, the amount of such taxes, assessments, insurance premiums, and other governmental charges, or any part thereof, plus interest thereon at the rate of six percent per annum from the date when such taxes, assessments, insurance premiums, and other governmental charges, or any part thereof, become delinquent, plus a prepayment premium.

D. A sum equal to the principal, interest, taxes, assessments, insurance premiums, and other governmental charges, or any part thereof, plus the amounts that will be sufficient to pay any taxes, assessments, insurance premiums, and other governmental charges, or any part thereof, plus taxes and assessments levied on the mortgaged property, all as estimated by the Mortgagor, less all sums already paid thereto, plus the amount of interest, or any part thereof, accrued on the date when such taxes, assessments, insurance premiums, and other governmental charges, or any part thereof, become delinquent, up to the date of payment to the Mortgagor, in trust, for payment and cancellation of such taxes, assessments, insurance premiums, and other governmental charges, or any part thereof.

E. All payments made by the Mortgagor under (d) of paragraph 2 preceding shall be added together and the aggregate amount thereof shall be paid to the Mortgagor, except that such a credit payment shall be applied to the Mortgagor on the 10th day, immediately thereafter.

F. Interest charges under the note, and the amounts of the taxes, assessments, insurance premiums, and other governmental charges, or any part thereof, plus the amounts specified in the note may be,

H. Taxes, assessments, insurance premiums, and other governmental charges, or any part thereof.

I. Interest on the principal balance, and

J. An amount of the principal balance.

Any deficiency in the amount of funds so deposited in this payment of all debts referred to in the note, or in the amount of the taxes, assessments, insurance premiums, and other governmental charges, or any part thereof, or in the amount of the principal balance, shall be paid by the Mortgagor within fifteen (15) days of accumulation, or the excess amount so paid in full shall be deemed a payment.

3. In the total of payments made by the Mortgagor under (t) of paragraph 2 preceding shall exceed the amount of payments actually made by the Mortgagor for taxes or assessments or insurance premiums, as the case may be, such excess, if the loan is current, at the option of the Mortgagor, shall be credited on subsequent payments to be made by the Mortgagor, or refunded to the Mortgagor. If however the monthly payments made by the Mortgagor under (t) of paragraph 2 preceding shall not be sufficient to pay taxes and assessments and insurance premiums, when the same shall become due and payable, then the Mortgagor shall pay to the Mortgagor any amount necessary to make up the deficiency, on or before the date when payment of such taxes, assessments, or insurance premiums shall be due. If at any time the Mortgagor shall tender to the Mortgagor, in accordance with the provisions of the note secured hereby, full payment of the same indebtedness represented thereby, the Mortgagor shall, in computing the amount of such indebtedness, credit to the account of the Mortgagor all payments made under the provisions of (a) of paragraph 2 hereof which the Mortgagor has not become obligated to pay to the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development, and any balance remaining in the funds accumulated under the provisions of (b) of paragraph 2 hereof. If there shall be a default under any of the provisions of this mortgage resulting in a public sale of the premises covered hereby, or if the property is otherwise acquired after default, the Mortgagor shall apply, at the time of the commencement of such proceedings, or at the time the property is otherwise acquired, the balance then remaining in the funds accumulated under (t) of paragraph 2 preceding, as a credit against the amount of principal then remaining unpaid under the note secured hereby, and shall properly adjust any payments which it ait have been made under (a) of paragraph 2.

4. That he will pay all taxes, assessments, water rates, and other governmental or municipal charges, fines, or impositions, for which assessment has not been made to him, and in default thereof the Mortgagor may pay the same, and that he will promptly deliver the official receipts therefor to the Mortgagor. If the Mortgagor fails to make any payments provided for in this section or any other payments for taxes, assessments, or the like, the Mortgagor may pay the same, and will incur no paid of all fees, interest, at the rate set forth in the note secured hereby from the date of such advance and shall be serviced in this manner.

5. That he will keep the premises in as good order and condition as they are now and will not commit or permit any waste thereof, reasonable wear and tear excepted.

6. That he will keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the mortgaged property insured as may be required from time to time by the Mortgagor against loss by fire and other hazards, casualties and contingencies in such amounts and for such periods as may be required by the Mortgagor and will pay promptly, when due, any premiums on such insurance provision for payment of which has not been made hereinbefore. All insurance shall be carried in companies approved by the Mortgagor and the policies and renewals thereof shall be held by the Mortgagor and have attached thereto loss payable clauses in favor of and in form acceptable to the Mortgagor. In event of loss Mortgagor will give immediate notice by mail to the Mortgagor, who may make proof of loss if not made promptly by Mortgagor, and each insurance company concerned is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for such loss directly to the Mortgagor instead of to the Mortgagor and Mortgagor jointly, and the insurance proceeds, or any part thereof, may be applied by the Mortgagor at its option either to the reduction of the indebtedness hereby secured or to the restoration or repair of the property damaged. In event of foreclosure of this mortgage or other transfer of title to the Mortgagor property in extinguishment of the indebtedness secured hereby, all right, title and interest of the Mortgagor in and to any insurance policies then in force shall pass to the purchaser or grantee.

7. That he hereby assigns all the rents, issues, and profits of the mortgaged premises from and after any default hereunder, and should legal proceedings be instituted pursuant to this instrument, then the Mortgagor shall have the right to have a receiver appointed of the rents, issues, and profits, who, after deducting all charges and expenses attending such proceedings and the execution of his trust as receiver, shall apply the residue of the rents, issues, and profits, toward the payment of the debt secured hereby.

8. That if the premises, or any part thereof, be condemned under any power of eminent domain, or acquired for a public use, the damages, proceeds, and the consideration for such acquisition, to the extent of the full amount of indebtedness upon this mortgage, and the note secured hereby remaining unpaid, are hereby assigned by the Mortgagor to the Mortgagor and shall be paid forthwith to the Mortgagor to be applied by it on account of the indebtedness secured hereby, whether due or not.
