MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

We, Roger D. Poole and Nancy S. Poole,

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagors) (SEND(S)) GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the full and exact sum of **Twenty-Nine Thousand Four hundred and No/100----- (\$29,400.00--)**

Dollars as evidenced by Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith which note does not include a provision for escalation of interest rate; paragraphs 9 and 10 of this mortgage provides for an escalation of interest rate under certain conditions; said note to be repaid with interest as the rate or rates then specified in installments of **Two hundred Thirty-Six and 57/100----- \$236.57----- Dollars each on the first day of each month thereafter in advance until the principal sum with interest has been paid out. All such payments to be applied first to the payment of interest computed monthly on unpaid principal balance and then to the payment of principal until the last payment of said note shall be due and payable **50** years after date and**

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of three days or more it shall be and shall remain in default and shall be any Rule or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any regulation, rule or order of this office, the whole amount then due thereunder shall at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable and such holder shall have the right to institute any action upon said note and sue collectable even to senior status, for the purpose of collecting said principal plus interest, plus costs and expenses for proceedings, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter draw upon said note in the Mortgage for said further sum as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance, premiums, expenses or for any other purpose.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN: That the Mortgagor is indebted unto said Mortgagee in the sum above the payment thereof and any further sum which may be advanced by the Mortgagor to the Mortgagee, and for and in consideration of the sum of **Three Dollars (\$3.00)** to the Mortgagee, well and truly paid by the Mortgagor to Mortgagee the 2nd day of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and granted to the Mortgagee, and the same is acknowledged by these presents, the Mortgagor doth give and release unto the Mortgagee, his executors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, part or lot of land with all improvements thereon or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the easterly side of Bear Grass Drive, and being shown as Lot No. 41 on the plat of Biltmore as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book Y, at Page 147, and having, according to a more recent *survey made by H. C. Clarkson, Jr., dated October, 1964, entitled property of Maxwell T. Watson, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the easterly side of Bear Grass Drive, said pin being the joint front corner of Lots 41 and 42 and running thence with the common line of said lots, S. 75-14 E. 137.8 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 41 and 42; thence, S. 3-15 E. 78.8 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 40 and 41; thence with the common line of said lots, N. 75-14 W. 162.2 feet to an iron pin on the easterly side of Bear Grass Drive; thence with the easterly side of Bear Grass Drive, N. 14-46 E. 75 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.

This is the same property conveyed to the Mortgagors herein by deed of Maxwell T. Watson dated December 27th, 1977, and being recorded simultaneously herewith in Deed Book **1070**, at Page **842**, of the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina.
