REAL ESTATE MORTGAGE FOR SOUTH CAROLINA

THIS MORTGAGE is made and entered into by

residing in Greenville County, South Carolina, whose post office address is  
Rt. 3, Davenport Road, Simpsonville, S. C. 29681, South Carolina

herein called "Borrower," and:

WHEREAS Borrower is indebted to the United States of America, acting through the Farmers Home Administration, United States Department of Agriculture, herein called the "Government," as evidenced by one or more promissory note(s) or assumption agreement(s), herein called "note," which has been executed by Borrower, is payable to the order of the Government, authorizes acceleration of the entire indebtedness at the option of the Government upon any default by Borrower, and is described as follows:

And the note evidences a loan to Borrower, and the Government, at any time, may assign the note and insure the payment thereof pursuant to the Consolidated Farm and Rural Development Act, or Title V of the Housing Act of 1949:

And it is the purpose and intent of this instrument that, among other things, at all times when the note is held by the Government, or in the event the Government should assign this instrument without insurance of the note, this instrument shall secure payment of the note; but when the note is held by an insured holder, this instrument shall not secure payment of the note or attach to the debt evidenced thereby, but as to the note and such debt shall constitute an indemnity mortgage to secure the Government against loss under its insurance contract by reason of any default by Borrower:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the loan(s) and (a) at all times when the note is held by the Government, or in the event the Government should assign this instrument without insurance of the payment of the note, to secure prompt payment of the note and any renewals and extensions thereof and any agreements contained therein, including any provision for the payment of an insurance or other charge, (b) at all times when the note is held by an insured holder, to secure performance of Borrower's agreement herein to indemnify and save harmless the Government against loss under its insurance contract by reason of any default by Borrower, and (c) in any event and at all times to secure the prompt payment of all advances and expenditures made by the Government, with interest, as hereinafter described, and the performance of every covenant and agreement of Borrower contained herein or in any supplementary agreement, Borrower does hereby grant, bargain, sell, release, and assign unto the Government, with general warranty, the following property situated in the State of South Carolina, County(ies) of Greenville

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and being shown as 1.0 acres on survey for Dorothy G. Seawright, prepared by Carolina Surveying Co., dated 30 May 1977, recorded in Plat Book 6F, Page 71, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin, which iron pin is N. 65-0 E., 77.5 feet from the centerline of 50 foot easement shown on said plat, and running thence N. 25-0 W., 290 feet to an iron pin; thence turning and running N. 79-07 E., 237.9 feet to an iron pin; thence turning and running S. 1-45 W., 95 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 9-20 W., 113 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 32-25 W., 100 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 65-0 W., 40 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.

Being the same property conveyed to Dorothy G. Seawright by deed of James Edwin Griffin, et al, recorded July 11, 1977, in Deed Book 1060, Page 205, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County.
