WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and impaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any foline to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgage, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may be reafter become indebted to the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose,

That the Mortzagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagor to the Mortzagor's account, and doo in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortzagor it and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is bereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortzagor its successors and assigns, the following described real estate.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with all improvements thereon or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the northeastern side of Prince Charming Drive, being shown and designated as Lot No. 6 on a plat of Enchanted Forest, made by Carolina Engineering and Surveying Co., dated February 18, 1963, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book YY at Page 123, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northeastern side of Prince Charming Drive at the joint front corners of Lots Nos. 5 and 6 and running thence with the common line of said Lots, N 62-0 E 140.0 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of property now or formerly belonging to Huff, S 28-0 E 65.5 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of property now or formerly belonging to Lions Club, S 56-22 W 140.5 feet to an iron pin on the northeastern side of Prince Charming Drive; thence with the northeastern side of Prince Charming Drive, N 28-0 W 79.5 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
