MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

Gordon R. Love and Linda C. Love

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) (SEND(S) GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIBST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee in the full and just sum of

Forty Thousand and no/100-----(\$ 40,000.00)

Dollars as evidenced by Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, which note a provision for escalation of interest rate (paragraphs 9 and 10 of this mortgage provides for an escalation of interest rate under certain

conditions), said note to be repaid with interest as the rate or rates therein specified in installments of Three Hundred

Thirty-five and 68/100----- (8 335.68) Dollars each on the first day of each month hereafter, in advance, until the principal sum with interest has been paid in full, such payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on unpaid principal balances, and then to the payment of principal with the list payment, if not sooner paid, to be due and payable 25 years after date, and

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose:

NOW KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagor to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagor at and before the scaling of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargainest, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagor its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land with all improvements thereon or hereafter to be constructed thereon situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the western side of Bethel Road in Austin Township, being shown and designated as the southernmost 1.50 acres of a 7.45 acre tract of the Property of Edwin F. Patterson, made by W. R. Williams, Jr., surveyor, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book 4-D at Page 191, and being shown on a more recent plat of the Property of Gordon R. Love and Linda C. Love made by Freeland and Associates dated January 5, 1978 as having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

-BEGINNING at an iron pin in or near the center of Bethel Road at the corner of property now or formerly owned by Charlie Jackson approximately 97 feet north of Gilders Creek and running thence along the Jackson line N. 72-56 W. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with said line, N. 11-30 W. 344 feet to a point; thence N. 14-15 W. 41.42 feet to an iron pin; thence through other property owned by Jean A. Glur S. 70-15 E. 301.51 feet to Ha spike in the right of way of Bethel Road; thence through the right of way of Bethel Road S. 19-45 W. 323.74 feet to the point of beginning.
