MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

Richardson and Johnson, A Partnership,

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) (SEND(S) GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the full and just sum of

Dollars, as evidenced by Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, which note a provision for escalation of interest rate (paragraphs 9 and 10 of this mortgage provides for an escalation of interest rate under certain

conditions), said note to be repaid with interest as the rate or rates therein specified in installments of

Two and 08/100 -----(\$ 562.08---) Dollars each on the first day of each month hereafter, in advance, until the principal sum with interest has been paid in full, such payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on unpaid principal balances, and then to the payment of principal with the last payment, if not sooner paid, to be due and payable 20 years after date; and

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagoe for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW. KNOW ALL MEN. That the Moragagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Moragager to the Moragagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Moragagor in hand well and truly paid by the Moragager at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Moragager, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, City of Greenville, on the easterly side of Williams Street, being shown as all of Lot 23 and part of Lot 22 on a plat of the property of Thomas F. Parker, recorded in the Office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County in Plat Book E, at Page 115 and being more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the easterly side of Williams Street at a point in the center of the front line of Lot 22 which pin is at the southwestern corner of the lot of land heretofore conveyed to Lottie Mae B. Lawton; thence with the line of the Lawton lot N. 73-10 E. 151.5 feet to a stake on westerly side of a 10-foot alley; thence with the northern side of said alley S. 68-52 W. 140 feet to an iron pin on Williams Street; thence with the eastern side of Williams Street N. 14-54 W. 85.5 feet to the point of beginning.
