WHEREAS. said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thuty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortzagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due the reunder shall at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for proceedings; and

That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgager to the Mortgager's a count, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgager it and before the scaling of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain sell and release unto the Mortgager its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, situate, lying and being on the northwestern side of Langley Road in O'Neal Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown and designated as a tract of land containing 10.52 acres, more or less, as shown on a plat entitled PROPERTY OF FRANK AND LUCY S. HALL, made by Terry T. Dill, dated April 21, 1969, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book 4-A at Page 183, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

REGINNING at an iron pin in Langley Road at the joint corner of the within described property and property now or formerly belonging to J. D. Anderson and running thence along the Anderson line N. 57-52 W. 178.5 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along the Anderson line S. 89-08 W. 598 feet to an iron pin in or near a creek; thence with the creek as the line N. 10-50 W. 320 feet to an iron pin in the line of property now or formerly belonging to Case; thence along the Case line N. 47-15 E. 625 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 44-28 E. 423.1 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 23-28 E. 500 feet to an iron pin in Langley Road; thence along Langley Road S. 66-30 W. 157.5 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning, together with right of ingress and egress over the private drive as shown on said plat.
