
THIS MORTGAGE made this 17th day of August 19 78 , among Wallace C. Craig (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) and FIRST UNION MORTGAGE CORPORATION, a North Carolina Corporation (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee):

AND WHEREAS, to induce the making of said loan, Mortgagor has agreed to secure said debt and interest thereon (together with any future advances) and to secure the performance of the undertakings prescribed in the Note and this Mortgage by the conveyance of the premises hereinafter described:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the aforesaid loan and the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) cash in hand paid to Mortgagor, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Mortgagor hereby grants, sells, conveys, assigns and releases to Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described premises located in Greenville
——County, South Carolina:

ALL that certain lot situated in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina in School District 8-AB and being designated as Lot 52 as shown on plat of the H. B. Bates property recorded in Plat Book P at Page 32, and having such metes and bounds as shown on said plat.

THIS being the same property conveyed to Luther Craig by deed of Ernest Patton, dated July 14, 1945, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S.C. on July 23, 1945 in Deed Book 278 at Page 163. Luther S. Craig died testate on March 20, 1968 and according to the records of his estate filed in the Probate Court for Greenville County in Apartment 1026, File 19, he devised all of his property to his wife, Addie A. Craig. Addie A. Craig died testate on November 26, 1975, and by her estate filed in the Probate Court for Greenville County, S.C. in Apartment 1404, File 4, devised the subject property to her son, Willace C. Craig, the mortgagor herein.



Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. Including but not limited to all buildings, improvements, fixtures, or appurtenances now or hereafter erected thereon, including all apparatus, equipment, fixtures, or articles, whether in single units or centrally controlled, used to supply heat, gas, air conditioning, water, light, power, refrigeration, ventilation or other services, and also together with any screens, window shades, storm doors and windows, screen doors, awnings, stoves and water heaters (all of which are declared to be a part of said real estate whether physically attached thereto or not).

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same with all privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging to Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, forever, for the purposes hereinafter set out and Mortgagor covenants with Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, that Mortgagor is seized of, and has the right to convey, the premises in fee simple; that the premises are free and clear of all encumbrances except for a prior Mortgage, if any; and that Mortgagor will warrant and defend title to the premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.

MORTGAGOR COVENANTS with Mortgagee, its heirs, successors and assigns as follows:

- 1. NOTE PAYMENTS. Mortgagor shall make timely payments of principal and interest on the above mentioned Note in the amounts, in the manner and at the place set forth therein. This Mortgage secures payment of said Note according to its terms, which are incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. TAXES. Mortgagor shall pay all taxes, charges and assessments which may become a lien upon the premises hereby conveyed before any penalty or interest accrues thereon and shall promptly deliver to Mortgagee (at its request) official receipts evidencing payment thereof. In the event of the passage after the date of this Mortgage of any law imposing a federal, state or local tax upon Mortgage or debts secured thereby, the whole principal sum (together with interest) secured by this Mortgage shall, at the option of Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, without notice become immediately due and payable.
