MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

WHEREAS, I, James H. Coble

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) is well and truly indebted unto Marion E. Tyus

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of Seventeen Thousand and no/100 ------

Dollars (\$17,000.00) due and payable in 120 monthly installments, including principal and interest, of Two Hundred Twenty-Four and 66/100 (\$224.66) Dollars each, the first such payment to be paid one month from date, and the remaining payments of like amount to be made on the same day of each succeeding month thereafter until paid in full

with interest thereon from date at the rate of ten (10)er centum per annum, to be paid: monthly

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may bereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purposes:


NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, shown on a plat entitled "Property of Catherine Susan Coble", dated July 6, 1978, by Freeland & Associates, said plat being recorded in Greenville County Plat Book 6 A at Page 5/, and having, according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit: BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeasterly side of White Horse Road at the Joint front corner of property now or formerly owned by Loures, and running thence with said Loures line, N. 4-03 W. 124.0 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner with property now or formerly owned by McCullough; thence with said McCullough line, N. 86-17 E. 92.7 feet to an old iron pin at the joint rear corner with property now or formerly owned by Neal; thence with said Neal line, S. 4-37 E. 232.68 feet to an iron pin on the northeasterly side of White Horse Road; thence on the northeasterly side of White Horse Road; thence on the northeasterly side of White Horse Road, N. 44-27 W. 71.3 feet to a nail and cap; thence continuing on the N.E. side of White Horse Road, N. 45-42 W. 73.4 feet to the point of beginning.

This property is subject to a 15 ft. right of way, for ingress and egress, a sewer easement, and to any other rights of way of record.

This is the same property conveyed to me by Marion E. Tyus by deed of even date herewith, to be recorded. This is a purchase money mortgage.

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Together with all and singular rights, members, herditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging in any way incident or appertaining, and of all the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures now or hereafter that the connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the moust household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its heirs, successors and assigns, forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and is lawfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except as provided lagein. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagoe forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

The Mortgagor further covenants and agrees as follows:

(1) That this mortgage shall secure the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs or other purposes pursuant to the covenants herein. This mortgage shall also secure the Mortgagee for any further loans, advances, readvances or credits that may be made hereafter to the Mortgagor by the Mortgagee so long as the total indebtedness thus secured does not exceed the original amount shown on the face hereof. All sums so advanced shall bear interest at the same rate as the mortgage debt and shall be payable on demand of the Mortgagee unless otherwise provided in writing.

(2) That it will keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the mortgaged property insured as may be required from time to time by the Mortgagee against loss by fire and any other hazards specified by Mortgagee, in an amount not less than the mortgage debt, or in such amounts as may be required by the Mortgagee, and in companies acceptable to it, and that all such policies and renewals thereof shall be held by the Mortgagee, and have attached thereto loss payable clauses in favor of, and in form acceptable to the Mortgagee, and that it will pay all Demiums therefor when due; and that it does hereby assign to the Mortgagee the proceeds of any policy insuring the mortgaged premises and does hereby authorize each insurance company concerned to make payment for a loss directly to the Mortgagee, to the extent of the balance owing on the Mortgage debt, whether due or not.

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
