"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the northern side of Piney Mountain Road, being a portion of Lots 44 and 45 of the sub-division of a part of the Estate of Peter Ligon, and having according to a survey made by R. E. Calton in June 1944, the following netes and bounds:

BEGINNING at a stake in Piney Mountain Road in line of property of A. C.
