It the total of payments made by the Mortgagor under (b) of paragraph 2 preceeding shall exceed the amount of payments actually made by the Mortgagee for taxes or assessments or insurance premiums, as the case may be, such excess, if the loan is current, at the option of the Mortgagor, shall be credited on subsequent payments to be made by the Mortgagor, or refunded to the Mortgagor. If there shall be a default under any of the provisions of this mostgage resulting in a public sale of the premises covered hereby, or if the property is otherwise acquired after default, the Mortpagee shall apply, at the time of the commencement of such proceedings, or at the time the property is otherwise acquired, the balance then remaining in the funds accumulated under (b) of paragraph 2 preceding, as a credit against the amount of principal then remaining unpaid under the note secured hereby, and shall properly adjust any payments which shall have been made under (a) of paragraph 2.
- 4. That he will pay all taxes, assessments, water rates, and other coremnantal or municipal charges, fines, or impositions, for which provision has not been made hereinbefore, and in default thereof the Mortgagee may pay the same; and that he will promptly deliver the official receipts therefor to the Mortgagee. If the Mortgager fails to make any payments provided for in this section or any other payments for taxes, assessments, or the like, the Mortgagee may pay the same, and all sums so paid shall bear interest at the rate set forthing he note secured hereby from the date of such advance and shall be secured by this mortgage.
- 5. That he will keep the premises in as good order and condition as they are now and will not commit or permit any waste thereof, reasonable wear and tear excepted

That he will keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the mortgaged property insured as may be required from time to time by the Mortgagee against loss by fire and other hazards, casualties and contingencies in such amounts and for such periods as may be required by the Mortgagee and will pay promptly, when due, any premiums on such insurance provision for payment of which has not been made hereinbefore. All insurance shall be carried in companies approved by the Mortgagee and the policies and renewals thereof shall be held by the Mortgagee and have attached thereto loss payable clauses in favor of and in form acceptable to the Mortgagee. That he hereby assigns all the rents, issues, and profits of the montgaged premises from and after any default hereunder, and should legal proceedings be instituted pursuant to this instrument, then the Montgagee shall have the right to have a receiver appointed of the rents, issues, and profits, who, after deducting all charges and expenses attending such proceedings and the execution of his trust as receiver, shall apply the residue of the rents, issues, and profits, toward the payment of the debt secured hereby.
- 8. That if the premises, or any part thereof, be condemned under any power of eminent damain, or acquired for a public use, the damages, proceeds, and the consideration for such acquisition, to the extent of the full amount of indebtedness upon this mortgage, and the note secured hereby remaining unpaid, are hereby assigned by the Mortgagor to the Mortgagee and shall be paid forthwith to the Mortgagee to be applied by it on account of the indebtedness secured hereby, whether due or not.

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
