Ed Gosnell died intestate in Greenville Edunty on August 27, 1911, as is shown by Apartment No. 1486, File No. 18, in the Office of the Probate Court for Greenville County. The children of Gracel Gosnell and Ed Gosnell convened their interest in this property to their mother, Grace Gosnell, by deed dated October 25, 1911, and recorded in Deed Books 1011, page 863, and 1011, page 864.

And the said Marguerite C. Mood agree S to insure the house and buildings on said lot in the sum of not less than \$22,296.00 Dollars, and keep the same insured from loss or damage by fire, and assign the policy of insurance to the said Grace Gosnell,

and that in the event the mortgagor shall at any time

fail to do so, then the said Grace Gosnell

may cause the same to be insured in her

name and reimburse Marguerite C. Mood for the premium and expense of such insurance under this mortgage.

And the said Marguerite C.
