situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Town of Fountain Inn, on the northern side of Cannon Street (also known as Cemtery Street) being shown as Lot B on plat prepared by W.M. Nash and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of Cemetary Street (Cannon St) at the line of property now or formerly of Peder McDowell and running thence, S 78-05 W 55 feet to an iron pin on the line of property now or formerly of Grave L.
