C., its successors and assigns:

That certain lot, parcel or tract of land, with all improvements now constructed thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, at the southern corner of the intersection of St. Marks Road and Jonquil Lane, being shown and designated as Lot No. 4 on plat of St. Marks l'anor, prepared by Kermit T. Gould, R.L.S., recorded in Plat Book 7C at Page 53 and being described more particularly, according to said plat, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of St. Marks Road at the joint front corner of Lots 3 and 4 and running thence along the western side of said road N. 36-52 W. 110 feet to an iron pin at the intersection of said road and Jonquil Lane; thence along the southern side of Jonquil Lane S. 59-09 W. 75 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of Lots 4 and 5; thence along the common line of said lots S. 36-52 E. 120 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of said lots in the line of Lot No. 3; thence along the common line of Lots No. 3 and 4 N. 61-31 E. 77.1 feet to an iron pin at the joint front corner of said lots, the point of beginning.
