- (c) Mortgagor shall at its sole expense obtain for, deliver to and maintain for the benefit of Mortgagee, during the life of this Mortgage, liability insurance policies relating to the Mortgaged Property, in such amounts, with such companies and in such form as may be reasonably required by Mortgagee. Mortgagee may require such policies to contain an endorsement, in form satisfactory to Mortgagee, naming Mortgagee as an additional insured thereunder. Mortgagor shall pay promptly, when due, any premiums on such insurance policies and renewals thereof.
- (d) Mortgagee may require Mortgagor to deposit with Mortgagee on the first day of each month, in addition to making payments of regular installments of principal and interest, until the Note is fully paid, an amount equal to one-twelfth (1/12) of the yearly premiums for all insurance. Such deposits shall not be, nor be deemed to be, trust funds, but may be commingled with the general funds of Mortgagee, and no interest shall be payable in respect thereof. Upon demand by Mortgagee, Mortgagor shall deliver to Mortgagee such additional monies as are necessary to make up any deficiencies in the amounts necessary to enable Mortgagee to pay such premiums when due. In the event of a default under any of the terms, covenants and conditions in the Note, this Mortgage or any other instrument securing the Note to be kept, performed or observed by Mortgagor, Mortgagee may apply to the reduction of the sums secured hereby, in such manner as Mortgagee shall determine, any amount under this paragraph remaining to Mortgagor's credit and any return premium received from cancellation of any insurance policy by Mortgagee upon foreclosure of this Mortgage.
 - (e) Mortgagee covenants and agrees with Mortgagor that it will require Mortgagor to make the above mentioned insurance deposits only in the occurrence of the following events: (a) A default in the loan occurs and is not corrected by Mortgagor within 60 days of said default, and (b) The insurance premiums are not paid by Mortgagor when due without penalty as required by this instrument.
 - 1.06 Condemnation. If all or any part of the Mortpaged Property shall be damaged or taken permanently through condemnation (which term when used herein shall include any damage or taking by any governmental authority or any other authority authorized by the laws of the state where the Land or Leasehold is located or the United States of America to so
