This matter came before the Court on Thursday, September 3, 1981, at 9:00 a.m., for a final hearing on the Petition of the petitioner seeking a divorce absolute from the respondent on the grounds of continuous separation for more than one year and the incorporation and approval of a Separation Agreement entered into by the parties.

Both parties appeared, the petitioner being represented by Thomas W. Greene, Attorney at Law, the respondent being represented by Rhoten N. Shetley, Attorney at Law. The Court has examined the verified pleadings and the testimony of the parties and finds that it has jurisdiction of these parties and subject matter of these proceedings.

At the call of the case the attorneys for the parties announced to the Court that the respondent did not contest petitioner's action for divorce and that all other issues had been resolved and incorporated into the agreements that will be outlined below. Both parties were sworn and testified. It appears from the testimony that the parties hereto were married on September 20, 1968, and that two children were born to the parties, namely John Henry Morgan, age 13, and Brian Adam Morgan, age 9. It further appears that the parties separated on or about May 19, 1980, and that they have lived apart, without cohabitation, for more than one year. This testimony was corroborated by Joe Morgan Blackwell of Greenville, South Carolina. It further appears that on or about October 10, 1980, the parties hereto entered into a document entitled
