To Secure to Lender (a) the repayment of the indebtedness evidenced by the Note, with interest thereon, the payment of all other sums, with interest thereon, advanced in accordance herewith to protect the security of this Mortgage, and the performance of the covenants and agreements of Borrower herein contained, and (b) the repayment of any future advances, with interest thereon, made to Borrower by Lender pursuant to paragraph 21 hereof (herein "Future Advances"), Borrower does hereby mortgage, grant and convey to Lender and Lender's successors and assigns the following described property located in the County of . Greenville, State of South Carolina:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and bieng in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, City of Greenville, being known and designated as part as Lot Number 62 of Furman and Haynsworth subdivision, and being more particularly shown on plat entitled "Property of Ralph Looper" prepared by Greeland and Associates, dated January 22, 1979 and recorded in Plat Book 6-Z at Page 21, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of Perry Avenue at the joint front corner of thie lot and property of McCombs, said point being 252 feet, more or less, from the intersection of Perry Avenue with Queen Street, and running thence along said Perry Avenue, N. 65-37 W. 50.2 feet to an old iron pin; thence turning and running, N. 22-33 E. 128.4 feet to an old iron pin; thence turning and running, S. 73-05 E. 50.0 feet to an old iron pin; thence turning and running, S. 22-22 W. 135.0 feet to the point of beginning.

This is that same property conveyed by deed of Helen B. Cann to Ralph Looper, dated January 22, 1979, recorded January 23, 1979, in Deed Volume 1095, at Page 863, in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, SC.

To Have and to Hold unto Lender and Lender's successors and assigns, forever, together with all the improvements now or hereafter erected on the property, and all easements, rights, appurtenances, rents, royalties, mineral, oil and gas rights and profits, water, water rights, and water stock, and all fixtures now or hereafter attached to the property, all of which, including replacements and additions thereto, shall be deemed to be and remain a part of the property covered by this Mortgage; and all of the foregoing, together with said property (or the leasehold estate if this Mortgage is on a leasehold) are herein referred to as the "Property".

Borrower covenants that Borrower is lawfully seised of the estate hereby conveyed and has the right to mortgage, grant and convey the Property, that the Property is unencumbered, and that Borrower will warrant and defend generally the title to the Property against all claims and demands, subject to any declarations, easements or restrictions listed in a schedule of exceptions to coverage in any title insurance policy insuring Lender's interest in the Property.
